项目背景

- 旧金山州立大学中文硕士项目与教育研究生院合作, 开设中文硕士学位+中小学教师资格通道, 以满足加州以及全美持续增长的多语教育需求。
- 旧金山州立大学中文项目始建于 1959 年,是美国最早的中文项目之一,在全美公立大学中常年排名前三。项目提供中文本科硕士学位课程,并主持多项美国联邦计划,包括中文领航项目(Chinese Flagship Program)以及战略语言计划专业口译及笔译认证(Strategic Language Initiative Translation-Interpretation Certificate Program)。
- 学校位于旧金山市内,临近伯克利、斯坦福等大学,以及圣荷西、奥克兰、 硅谷等教育科技中心。往届毕业生就业于 K-16 学校、政府部门、教育科技公司、新闻媒体、以及出版行业,或进入不同专业博士项目继续高等教育。

学位选项

- 中文硕士(30学分, 2-5学期, 取决于是否转学分, full-time or part-time)
- 中文硕士(2学期)+小学全科教师资格,含双语教师认证(2 or 3 学期)
- 中文硕士(2学期)+中学单科(外语)教师资格(2学期)

教师资格认证通道

- 如选择教师资格通道,硕士第一学期报考 C-BEST、C-SET 等教师认证班资格入学考试,并累积申请教师资格认证项目所需之 45 小时见习时数。
- 硕士第二学期申请教师资格项目。

学分合作

- 经中文系以及研究生部审核认可,硕士阶段可从其他高校转入一定课程,上至9学分。
- 硕士与教师资格认证项目之间 互认6学分。

- 州内学生约 8000/年
- 州外以及国际学生约 \$13,000
- 参考生活费约 \$20,000;
- 奖学金资助: 学校以及中文系每年提供若干奖学金申请和竞选。

学术及职业前景

- 硕士期间可申请现代语言文学系助教,也可担任美国联邦中文领航项目语言辅导。
- 完成硕士后可申请博士项目,或进入美国大学、私立中小学就业。
- 取得加州教师认证后有资格担任公立中小学教职。
